Since the beginning of this year, 22 Australians have been killed at work. Last year, 190 Australians were killed at work. The year before that, it was 187 workplace deaths.

Remembering those that have suffered and lost their lives, renew the fight for safer workplaces, adequate Workers Compensation entitlement's, care and support for the injured.
